B: Physics Understanding is GOOD every week.

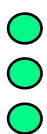
MARKING PERIOD GRADE: B

A: Physics Understanding is GOOD and you WOWed me twice.

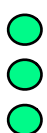
MARKING PERIOD GRADE: A

WEEK 1: Your Physics Understanding is Good

WEEK 2: Wow - you went beyond

WEEK 4: Wow - you went beyond



Wow = You went beyond during that week.

How? By learning something related to what we did on your own, or applying what we learned outside the classroom, or making up your own set of mathematical problems & solving them, or . . .

C: There was at least one week where your Physics Understanding was just OKAY.
(You can still fix it!)

D or F: There was at least one week where you had a NOPE.
(You can still fix it!)

MARKING PERIOD GRADE: D or F

D or F depends on how many "Nopes."
